1. Purpose. Establish Navy Flight Demonstration Squadron (NFDS) training standardization and safety evaluation procedures directed by Chief of Naval Air Training (CNATRA) per reference (a) paragraph (P) and carried out per references (b) through (h).

2. Scope. This notice is published to provide information concerning the NFDS Standardization and Safety evaluation to be held 8 August 2012. The evaluation will be conducted utilizing reference (b) as a guide for in-depth review of training, standardization, and operations. However, due to the unique nature of the NFDS, the inspection checklists contained in reference (b) will be tailored as required. Additionally, review of an improved Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) or squadron instruction maneuver guide will be treated as a Special Interest Item, per reference (a) paragraph (W). Items to be inspected for Training/Standardization/Operations, Safety/NATOPS and Medical/Aeromedical are listed in Enclosure (1).

3. Concurrent with this evaluation and per references (c) and (d), CNATRA will conduct an Occupational Safety and Health Management Evaluation (OSHME) of the NFDS.

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4. By 16 July, provide copies of squadron SOP, squadron instructions governing flight demonstrations, and any other applicable squadron-level policy documents to LCDR Marcus Dodd, CNATRA Strike Pipeline Training Officer (PTO), DSN 861-3895, Commercial (361) 961-3895, via email at daryl.dodd@navy.mil. Any changes to the schedule should be coordinated through LCDR Dodd. The uniform for the evaluation will be appropriate working uniform.

5. Request all applicable NFDS personnel be available throughout the evaluation, and a conference room or similar space be provided as a work center for the inspection team.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This Notice shall remain in effect for one year unless cancelled by CNATRA or superseded by a CNATRA Notice on the same subject.
