1. Purpose. To provide standardized procedures for managing the flight Training Squadron TWENTY-SEVEN (VT-27) student Military Aviators (SMAs) with previous flight experience.
2. Cancellation. VT-27-INST 1542.1
3. Background. The accelerated syllabus benefits the military by eliminating unnecessary training sorties, saving time and money.
4. Procedures. The flight leader will be responsible for managing accelerated students in his/her flight. All SMAs will be screened for acceleration during flight leader check-in.
 - a. All SMA that qualify for the accelerated program will be briefed by the Student Control Officer on the nature of the program and documentation maintained in the students ATJ. Disclosure of prior flight time is mandatory on student check-in and shall be documented by Student Control personnel. Failure to disclose prior flight time is a violation of the Integrity Clause of reference (a) and may result in the administrative or legal action.
 - b. SMAs who have not flown within the past 2 years shall not be accelerated.
 - c. Students identified for acceleration will complete the accelerated student supplementary jacket form in their ATJ, enclosure (1), with their flight leader, indicating previous flight hours and FAA ratings, if any. A copy of the form will be placed in the front of the student's mini-ATJ on the right-hand side to ensure all IPs are aware of the student's accelerated status.

d. The flight leader will create an initial write-up in TIMS to annotate the SMA's accelerated status as per enclosure (2).
