Subj: FUEL LOADING REQUIREMENTS FOR TH-57 AIRCRAFT

1. Purpose. To establish standard fuel loads for Training Air Wing FIVE helicopters.

2. Cancellation. COMTRAWINGFIVEINST 4028.1A

3. Action

a. TH-57B aircraft should be fueled to 65 gallons unless otherwise specified on the flight schedule.

b. TH-57C aircraft should be fueled to 75 gallons unless otherwise specified on the flight schedule. TH-57Cs entering phase maintenance or being sent to the test board requiring a maintenance autorotation, should be fueled to 65 gallons vice the standard load of 75 gallons. This loading will increase flight safety and reduce the possibility of an overtorque during the test flight.
