COMTRAWING ONE INSTRUCTION 5530.1A

Subj: PHYSICAL SECURITY MEASURES FOR TRAINING AIR WING ONE

Ref: (a) NASMERMSINST 3300.1(series)
(b) OPNAVINST 5530.14(series)

1. Purpose. In accordance with reference (a), this instruction is intended to inform Training Air Wing ONE of Physical Security Instructions and measures in place at Training Air Wing ONE. This instruction and reference (a) will also inform and educate everyone concerned of measures that must be taken in case of a terrorist attack or any change in Threat Condition (THREATCON) aboard Naval Air Station Meridian (NAS Meridian).

2. Cancellation. COMTRAWINGONEINST 5530.1


3. Background. Many of Training Air Wing ONE Information Security (INFOSEC) measures work in conjunction with Physical Security measures. However, this instruction does not address INFOSEC measures at Training Air Wing ONE.

a. In conjunction with this instruction, Training Air Wing ONE adopted reference (a) as its Force Protection Instruction to provide guidance in NAS Meridian THREATCON, or in the event of a terrorist attack.

b. Training Air Wing ONE hangar is not secured after hours by an alarm system. Personnel that see suspicious activity are required to report it to base security.

4. Action. In the event of NAS Meridian changing THREATCON to THREATCON BRAVO-PLUS or a more elevated threat condition, the Training Air Wing ONE Operation Duty Officers (ODO's) are to:

1. Notify the Commanding Officer of the change of THREATCON.
