Instructor and student eject from U.S. Navy T-6B near Foley, Alabama; both safe

CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS - At approximately 10:50 a.m. CST, a Navy instructor pilot and a student aviator ejected from a T-6B Texan II, assigned to Training Air Wing 5, in the vicinity of Barin Naval Outlying Field near Foley, Alabama.

The aircrew successfully ejected from the aircraft and have been treated for minor injuries. No other significant injuries have been reported at this time.

The aircraft's location has been discovered in a remote, unpopulated area.

The cause of the incident is under investigation.
