Subj: OPERATIONS IN SUPPORT OF CORTRAMID/PROTRAMID ORIENTATION FLIGHTS

1. Purpose. To publish policies and assign responsibilities for conducting orientation flights for midshipmen participating in the FY-15 Midshipman Summer Training Programs.

2. Background. Reference (a) is the Naval Air Training Operating Procedures Standardization (NATOPS) General Flight and Operating Instructions. Reference (b) provides Naval Air Training Command (NATRACOM) policy and procedures for reporting and investigating aircraft mishaps and hazards.

3. Discussion. Detachments will be established and will be comprised of personnel and aircraft from Training Air Wing (TRAWING) FOUR. Detachment tasking is listed below.

a. Participating midshipmen will require appropriate Naval Aviation Survival Training Program (NASTP) training for the T-34C.

b. Weekly requirements for orientation flights will be:

(1) WEST COAST - up to 100 sorties per week for first four week period and up to 125 sorties per week during the next eight week period;

(2) EAST COAST - up to 100 sorties per week for both four week periods. Plan includes flying Monday through Thursday with Friday as a back-up day.

c. TRAWING FOUR Commander may conduct direct liaison or may authorize detachment Officers-in-Charge (OICs) to liaison directly with the respective Commander, Naval Air Force Atlantic (CNAL) or Commander, Naval Air Force Pacific (CNAP) CORTRAMID/PROTRAMID representative for resolution of issues regarding the detachment sites. OICs are required to hold the rank of LCDR/MAJ or above. POCs are listed below.

#### 4. Action

a. TRAWING FOUR

(1) Detachment OIC: Provide a daily operations summary to the respective TRAWING Operations Officer, CNATRA N33 and N331 via email using enclosure (1). Ensure all totals remain up-to-date and use note section to explain daily schedule execution shortfalls or overages.

(2) Aircraft mishap and investigation responsibilities will be established via separate correspondence.

(3) Provide CNATRA N33 and N386 with a lessons learned report from each detachment site within two weeks of completion of detachment operations.

(4) Detachment OICs will ensure positive control of midshipmen from morning check-in until completion of orientation flight.

b. CNATRA DET CORPUS CHRISTI

(1) Provide a Maintenance lessons learned report from each detachment site to CNATRA N33, N386 and N4 within two weeks of completion of each detachment, if required.

(2) CNATRA DET CORPUS CHRISTI will provide logistical support to ensure proper Aviation Life Support System (ALSS) equipment (vests, helmets, O2 masks, and gloves) are provided to both DET sites. CNATRA DET CORPUS CHRISTI will coordinate with CNATRA Administrative Contracting Officer (ACO) and maintenance contractor management to provide contract manpower at both DET sites.

5. General

a. Travel Orders. CNATRA N8 will provide TRAWING financial analysts a special job order for use with the Defense Travel System (DTS) in generating travel orders (detachment support only). CNATRA N8 will use job order information for reimbursement of the TRAWING.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This notice will remain in effect for a period of one year, or until it is replaced by another notice of the same subject.
