Subj: CNATRA T-6 OBOGS FAIL WARNING LIGHT GUIDANCE

(d) DOC/CNASC/NATOPS FLIGHT MANUAL T-6B/01DEC2017//

1. Purpose. This notice cancels reference (a) and provides guidance for Chief of Naval Air Training (CNATRA) T-6 Texan II aircraft operating in accordance with references (b) through (d) when an On-Board Oxygen Generating System (OBOGS) Fail warning light illuminates.
2. OBOGS Operations. Normal flight operations in accordance with references (b) through (d) are authorized with the following conditions:
 - a. If the OBOGS Fail warning light illuminates, T-6A shall execute procedures in accordance with reference (c). For T-6B with PCL at IDLE, execute procedures in accordance with reference (d). Aircrews will only attempt to clear the OBOGS Fail Warning light once. With PCL above IDLE or re-illumination of the OBOGS Fail Warning light, T-6B shall execute the following:
 - *1. OBOGS FAILURE/PHYSIOLOGICAL SYMPTOMS Checklist - Execute.
 - b. Flight crews will brief the ODO upon RTB on all OBOGS Fail warning lights. Record aircraft side number, time of occurrence during event, altitude, power setting, regime of flight (taxi, take-off, maneuvering, or straight and level), in flight trouble shooting (if throttles were advanced and how far), if the light cleared, if the light returned, and any additional comments/remarks.
3. Intent. The intent of this guidance is to reduce the risk of inducing a physiological episode due to extended flight with an OBOGS malfunction.
4. Acknowledgment. All aircrew shall acknowledge this Notice via squadron Read and Initial prior to next flight.

6. Cancellation Contingency. This Notice shall remain in effect until the cancellation date, until superseded by an updated Notice with the same subject, or cancelled by instruction.
