Subj: SAFETY STANDDOWN POLICY

Ref: (a) CNATRAINST 3750.24F

1. Purpose. To promulgate Training Air Wing ONE (TW-1) Safety Standdown policy to subordinate commands.
2. Cancellation. COMTRAWINGONEINST 3750.1C
3. Discussion. Reference (a) assigns responsibility to individual commands to conduct quarterly Safety Standdowns. This program provides an opportunity for instructors, students, enlisted personnel and civilian employees to focus on safety issues.
4. Action
 - a. TW-1 will standdown to participate in CNATRA directed quarterly Safety Standdown Programs. The goal is to ensure maximum readiness through increased aviation and ground safety awareness.
 - b. Aviators, ground officers, and simulator instructors shall participate with their respective command for discussion of aviation and ground safety related activities.
 - c. Enlisted and Civil Service personnel shall attend the ground portion of Quarterly Safety Standdowns or muster separately for discussion of ground safety topics as directed by their department supervisor.
 - d. Squadron Safety Officers shall submit After Action/Squadron Muster Reports to the TW-1 Safety Officer NLT 7 days following completion of scheduled events. The reports shall contain final agendas and any pertinent comments or recommendations.
