VT-22's Mission is to train the next generation of Fighter/Attack and E2/C2 pilots for the Navy and Marine Corps team. To do so, we will work together to provide a climate that is professional, treating all with respect and dignity. We will remain focused on our mission to continue to provide the finest Naval Aviators to the fleet so they can deploy in support of our nation's objectives.

Safety Policy: We will incorporate ORM in all aspects of our lives and always look out for SNA's, IP's and the civilians around us. In doing so, we will adhere to the adage that a sound tactical plan is inherently safe.
