### TRAINING SQUADRON TWENTY-SEVEN INSTRUCTION 3700.2B

Subj: PRACTICE PREFLIGHT AIRCRAFT PROCEDURES

1. Purpose. To establish squadron policy and responsibility for the use of Commander, Training Air Wing FOUR (CTW-4) T-34C aircraft as practice preflight aircraft and procedures trainers.

2. Scope. This instruction applies to all Training Squadron TWENTY-SEVEN (VT-27) personnel utilizing CTW-4 T-34C aircraft.

3. Cancellation. VT-27INST 3700.2A

4. Policy

a. Only CTW-4 T-34C instructors and students may utilize designated preflight aircraft.

b. No T-34C may be used as a practice preflight/procedures aircraft unless specifically designated as such by the maintenance contractor (the designated aircraft's side number and location is normally posted in the aircraft issue office).

c. Engine turns and the use of battery or external power are prohibited. Each instructor/student shall ensure the battery is disconnected prior to utilizing the aircraft.

d. The condition lever shall remain in the "Fuel Off" position at all times.


e. When preflight/procedures practice is complete, the instructor/student shall ensure all knobs, switches, levers, etc., are in the same position as they were at the completion of the prestart check list (with the exception of parking break - off).

f. Persons other than CTW-4 T-34C instructors/students are considered to be guests. Guests may be military or civilian personnel and must be sponsored and escorted by a CTW-4 T-34C instructor/student. The general public is not permitted to view or embark the aircraft at any time.

g. Guests shall not be left unattended in the cockpit at anytime.

h. Guests are not authorized on the flight line during flight operations or in the vicinity of an aircraft with its engine turning.
