Subj: NATOPS GENERAL FLIGHT AND OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Ref: (a) OPNAVINST 3710.7U

1. Purpose. To establish authority for approval of local and cross-country flights.

2. Cancellation. VT-27INST 3710.7E

3. Background. Reference (a) designates the Commanding Officer as the authority to approve flights of assigned aircraft.

4. Action.

a. The Executive Officer is delegated approval authority for all cross-country and local flights.

b. The Operations Officer or, in his/her absence, the Assistant Operations Officer, is the delegated authority to approve all local training syllabus flights and instructor proficiency flights.

c. The Operations Duty Officer, in the performance of his/her duties, may authorize additional Student Military Aviators and Instructors Under Training, syllabus flights to maximize effectiveness consistent with current weather and aircraft availability.

d. The Maintenance Liaison Officer may authorize additional post-maintenance functional check flights to ensure a high level of RFT aircraft are available.

e. Authorization for flight shall be documented by a published flight schedule signed by competent authority. All flights authorized, in addition to those published in the daily flight schedule, shall be written in the master flight schedule by the Operations Duty Officer.
