Vigilance and attention to detail are essential in protecting and preserving our limited resources. A positive dynamic approach to safety with actively engaged leadership at all levels will ensure our success.

We operate by the book and accept no unnecessary risk. Everyone is a safety officer and responsible for how we conduct business. All personnel shall adhere to governing directives, instructions, and notices to help safeguard mission execution. The Safety Department has been charged with establishing a proactive and aggressive program designed to detect and minimize hazards as well as advance safety awareness throughout the squadron.

If it cannot be done safely, don't do it. We employ Operational Risk Management (ORM) as a matter of our daily conduct. I expect the principles of ORM to be factored into our decision making whether at work, in the aircraft, or off duty. I will never fault anyone for making the safe decision.
