VT-6 Briefing Space Set Up Guide

A student's preflight brief sets the tone of the flight and specifies the manner of safe efficient execution. A professional brief, military bearing and neat personal appearance are essential. Briefing spaces shall be kept orderly and free of clutter. This guide is designed to make personal boards unnecessary and save you time! **Personal white boards are prohibited at VT-6.**

<u>The goal of these procedures is to prevent any duplication of effort!</u> In all cases, SNA's shall bring two fully filled out event kneeboard cards. DO NOT WRITE A PROPOSED PROFILE ON THE CARDS as it is subject to change. NEATNESS and good handwriting is a must! PRO TIP: If you are trying to select strike or go the extra mile, clean and condition the whiteboard with specialized dry erase board conditioner prior to the brief. This will enhance your presentation and preserve our squadron whiteboards.

System drawings: Any student wishing to receive a 5 will efficiently draw a system from memory stating all nomenclature and all information form NATOPS. Students are permitted to bring a single sheet of paper with a pre-drawn system that is not labeled for discussion.

- Skyvector: Ensure weather radar is selected in layers.
- Aviationweather.gov: home page acceptable to let IP select weather products.
- Colorado State University RAMMB Slider for detailed satellite imagery (optional)
- Defense Internet NOTAM Service (DINS): pull up all NOTAMS for possible route of flight. Pro tip-use flight path search and click "en-route airports" and "ARTCC/UIR/FIR".
- Navy FWB w/current on top DD-175-1 [Link available on DINS]
- FAA TFR's graphical depiction [Link available on DINS]
- USAHAS Bird Avoidance Model [Link available on DINS]
- RUC Soundings (optional based on WX)
- VT-6 Schedule Front Page
