1. Purpose. To list personnel authorized to make NATOPS Flight Personnel Training/Qualification Jacket and Pilot/NFO/SNFO Flight Log entries.

3. Action

a. Per references (a) and (b), the following personnel are authorized to make qualification and achievement entries, approve logbook entries, make negative accident and flight violation entries in all Pilot, NFO and SNFO Logbooks, and NATOPS Flight Personnel Training/Qualifications Jackets, as indicated:



b. Under normal conditions, qualification and achievement entries should be made by the T-45 NATOPS Officer. Flight-by-flight entries should be made by the Operations/Logs and Records Clerk. Flight-by-flight approval shall be made by the Commanding Officer or Operations Officer. Negative accident and flight rule violation entries should be made by the ASO. Mishap record entries shall be made by the Commanding Officer.

c. Personnel filling billets listed above will familiarize themselves with reference (a) as appropriate.
