Subj: EMERGENCY INFORMATION

- 1. All emergency information will be disseminated via the Training Air Wing Six Facebook page.
- 2. It is **HIGHLY** recommended that you follow our Facebook page: Search Training Air Wing Six and like us.
  - Once you like our page click on "More";
  - Click on "Notifications";
  - Click on "Edit Notifications";
  - Under Post click on "Status update"
- 3. Following a natural disaster, terrorist event, or mandatory evacuation, proceed to a safe location/safe haven. <u>All Navy and DoD civilian personnel shall</u> report status and whereabouts via NFAAS ASAP utilizing the mobile app or website discussed below:

**NFAAS APP --** FREE Disaster readiness based app for Sailors and their families. The app is easy to use and covers all that is needed to be prepared before and during a disaster.



- Easy to navigate.
- Download in the Apple or Android App Store.
- Includes PRE, DURING and POST disaster resource information.
- Users are able to create custom emergency kits and plans that meet the requirements of their family.
- FFSC locator shows the closest military installation where assistance is available.
  RSS Feeds with current weather conditions for local and regional area.
- Built in weather alert. Similar to the Emergency Broadcast System, this function automatically initiates a visual and audio alert to a smart phone based on the user's area.
- App provides option to save important information such as special medical needs and insurance policy data. App provides a resource page with direct links to FEMA, ARC, etc.
- Built-in survey feedback mechanism.
- App links to the NFAAS Mobile Website.

**NFAAS Mobile Website** -- The mobile website is a minimized version of NFAAS, making the system much easier to view and navigate while using a handheld mobile device.



- A mobile phone web page accessible through a smartphone web browser. There is no app to download.
- Smartphone friendly user interface.
- Simple steps lead the user through accountability, location and contact update, and assessment (if required)

## Subj: EMERGENCY INFORMATION

Department Heads will make status reports to their respective Executive Officer. Squadron Executive Officers and Wing Department Heads will make status reports to the Chief Staff Officer.
