Subj: TRAINING AIR WING SIX SAFETY STAND DOWN

1. Purpose. This notice announces the Training Air Wing (TRAWING) SIX Safety Stand Down to be held on 3 January 2017.

2. General. The Safety Stand Down will be a consolidated evolution involving all TRAWING SIX squadrons and 2nd German Training Squadron, USA. It will be held in the Mustin Beach Club. The Safety Stand Down will consist of briefs organized by VT-86. The Stand Down will begin promptly at 0900. Everyone shall be seated by 0845. After the all-hands briefs at the Mustin Beach Club, squadrons will conduct T/M/S specific training at a time and place designated by squadron Commanding Officers.

3. Action

- a. Respective squadron Commanding Officers shall ensure promulgation of this Notice.
- b. All Contract Pilots and Simulator Instructors will be conducting in house training in their designated spaces during the Safety Stand Down.
- c. Squadron Safety Officers shall coordinate Command efforts in executing this Notice. Safety Officers are responsible for their respective squadron's muster reports.
- d. The TRAWING SIX Safety Department has reserved the Mustin Beach Club.
- e. No TRAWING SIX flight, simulator, or academic events shall be scheduled during the Safety Stand Down.
- f. Squadrons shall each provide a five student working party for set up and tear down. They will muster with Lieutenant Jones at the Mustin Beach Club at 0800.
