Subj: COMMANDING OFFICER'S NAVY STANDARD SCORE (NSS) POLICY

Ref: (a) CNATRINST 1542.155B  
(b) CNATRANOTE 1500  
(c) TRARONTENINST 1500.4B

1. Purpose. To establish procedures per references (a) through (c) and to comply with reference (b).

2. NSS scores for all VT-10 students will be run every Monday morning.

a. If a student's NSS score is 35.0 or above, that student will continue to train normally.


b. If a student's NSS score is 34.9 or below, the following will be accomplished:

(1) If a student is not currently on Student Monitoring Status (SMS) they will be placed on SMS until the current phase of training is complete or until their NSS Score has reached 40.0, whichever occurs first.

(2) The student's next End of Block (EOB) event will be scheduled as an Initial Progress Check (IPC), or if an IPC has already been flown in that phase of training (i.e. Primary, Intermediate, etc.), the flight will be a Final Progress Check (FPC).

(a) Failure of any IPC will result in an FPC as per reference (a).

(b) Failure of any FPC will result in Training Review Board procedures.
