VT-86 COMMANDING OFFICER'S SUBSTANCE ABUSE POLICY

Alcohol abuse and the distribution, possession, use, trafficking or distribution of illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia is contrary to effective performance and to the VT-86 mission, and will not be tolerated. Substance abuse is also a safety and readiness issue – it endangers each member of the squadron and erodes the trust and confidence we all must have in each other to accomplish our mission safely.


If you are going to drink alcohol, do so responsibly and encourage others to do the same. Have a plan. Always establish a designated driver or arrange other safe transportation home. **Don't drink and drive.**

Navy and Marine Corps policy prohibits the distribution, possession, use, trafficking, or distribution of illegal drugs and intentional misuse of prescription drugs, and I have no tolerance for such actions. Anyone found to be involved with illegal drugs may immediately be subjected to legal and disciplinary action.
